- Make checks payable to: PCPA
- Return completed order form, 8 ½X11 artwork to be used, and a check payable to the PCPA, in the protective bag provided, no later than **Friday, March 15th**, to your child's teacher

Orders will arrive the first week of May, in time for Mother's Day and Teacher's Appreciation Day!

If the enclosed artwork is not your preference to transformed into a keepsake offered on the attached order form, we welcome you to encourage your child to create one at home. If you have younger children at home, they are invited to create their own art to be transformed. When creating artwork at home, please familiarize yourself with these requirements of artwork to be submitted for used:

- Artwork is created using 8 ½ x 11 paper ONLY.
- Results are best if square art is avoided.
- Be sure to have the children place their names on the back.
- Use bright bold colors (markers, paints, crayons & colored pencils only)
- Please keep name & important information one (1) inch away from ALL edges of paper
- NO TRADEMARKED SUBJECTS will be accepted (Mickey Mouse, Sponge Bob, etc.)
- Completing the “description of artwork” column is important, especially when multiple pieces are returned
